Role Description – Assistant Coach

Description

An Assistant Coach works mainly but not exclusively with young players, always under the supervision of an ECB Coach qualified at Level II or higher. The primary aims of the role are to support the coaches in developing general athletic, cricket and personal skills in individual young players, and in fostering a sense of team spirit and pride in Henfield Cricket Club.

Qualifications and Requirements

- ECB Assistant Coach award at UKCC Level I
- Clear CRB check.

Main Duties

- To assist in the planning, running and supervision of a designated group of young players during junior practice sessions on The Common or other specified practice sessions to be agreed.
- To run cricket coaching sessions as agreed with and under the supervision of a Coach.
- To work with other Coaches as required in the planning, running and development of junior cricket at Henfield.
- To assist the Coach in team selection and team administration.
- To assist in the supervision young players at matches and other events both home and away.
