Role Description – Coach

Description

A Junior Coach works mainly but not exclusively with young players. The primary aims of the role are to develop general athletic, cricketing and personal skills in individual young players, and to foster a sense of team spirit and pride in Henfield Cricket Club among the team(s) for which the coach is responsible and the Club as a whole.

Qualifications and Requirements

- ECB Level 1 or ECB Coach Award at UKCC Level II and membership of the ECB Coaches Association.
- Clear CRB check

Main Duties

- To work with the Cricket Development Manager and other junior coaches in the planning, running and supervision of junior practice sessions, and the development of junior cricket at Henfield.
- To take responsibility for the planning, running and supervision of a designated group of young players during agreed junior practice sessions on The Common and indoors.
- To be responsible for the safety, welfare and enjoyment of all players under his/her supervision, according to both ECB and Henfield Cricket Club codes of conduct and policies.
- To manage any helpers and assistant coaches, who may or may not be ECB qualified.
- To appoint the playing captain for his/her designated age group.
- To select the team for his/her designated age group matches, according to Club selection principles.
- To supervise the playing of the team at matches and competitions both home and away.
- To work with the Cricket Development Manager and other junior coaches in establishing dialogue with senior team captains in identifying players with potential to play at senior level and agreeing development needs.
- To work with the Cricket Development Manager and other junior coaches in identifying talented players who might be able to play at representative level, and to nominate those players to the area co-ordinators.
- To communicate regularly with the parents and carers of young players.
