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ECB Introductory Course: This course provides a basic 6-hour introduction to the skills and knowledge required to effectively assist a qualified coach in introducing and developing cricket amongst young people in a safe and enjoyable environment. It is a non-assessed course, though candidates will receive an attendance certificate. The course aims to:

- provide skills training to club section volunteers/helpers to enable cricket to be introduced to young cricketers in a fun and enjoyable way.
- give club junior section volunteers/helpers current and up to date information on the teaching/coaching of cricket skills.
- give adults/junior volunteers a better understanding of the deliver of cricket with safe, effective and organised practices.

Minimum Age = 16 years old

Level 1 – Coaching Assistant: The role of the coaching assistant is to work with Level 2 coaches delivering specific aspects of coaching sessions on their own. This may include running warm ups / cool downs, small sided games and small group work. You will be provided with a variety of resources to support your learning including coaching cards, a DVD and a workbook.

The Level 1 course is an assessed course and is suitable for anyone who wishes to get involved with junior coaching.

Minimum Age = 16 years old

Level 2 – Coach Award: The role of the ECB Coach is to prepare, deliver and review cricket coaching sessions. This may include planning and leading technical coaching sessions, running games to promote learning or developing player's fitness and concentration. You will be required to complete 10 hours of 'Supported Coaching Practice' which will give you an opportunity to develop your coaching skills 'out in the field' whilst being supervised by a more qualified coach. You will be provided with a variety of resources to support your learning including coaching cards, a DVD and a workbook.

The Level 2 course is suitable for you if you wish to be a lead coach at a club or school or if you wish to progress to coach at a higher level. If you already have some coaching experience and / or have played to a reasonable level, you may be able to do this course without attending a Level 1 course. Minimum Age = 18 years old
